

# THE RULES

The Z20 Let Lovers PVS Race Wars Shoot Out is made up of two challenges; how fast you can go up the drag strip, and how fast you can pilot your car around a tricky handling circuit.

By entering The Shoot Out you will receive three runs up the drag strip, and three attempts at the handling circuit throughout the day. Your fastest time on the strip will be added to your fastest time on the handling circuit, and the winner will be the person with the lowest combined time.



## DRIVERS REQUIREMENTS

- All drivers must be 18 or over
- All drivers must have a full driving licence and must display both original parts on the day of the event or they will be disqualified from the competition
- Only the car owner can drive the car in the competitions, no driver swapping will be permitted
- Helmets are compulsory and must be worn for all activities
- Drivers must have arms and legs covered at all times whilst driving, no overalls will be available for hire on the day
- Seatbelts or harnesses are compulsory and must be worn during all activities
- Drivers must sign an indemnity form and all other relevant paperwork on the day before taking part in any activity
- Wristbands will be provided once every driver has signed up to the activity and must be worn and kept on all day. Anyone without a relevant wristband for the activity will not be allowed to compete

## HANDLING COURSE

- This is all about control and handling. A course will be set up to not only test your car but your driving skills
- You will be given one 'sighting lap', then your next lap will be against the clock. You will only get one sighting lap.
- Navigate the circuit in the quickest time to win
- We will be using Race Logic Video Pro Vboxes to record your circuit times, which will be available to take home with you on the day, via a USB for £5.

**You must drive carefully and slowly around site when you are not on the strip or the handling circuit.**

## VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

- Your car must be a Vauxhall model
- Your vehicle must be in suitable condition for circuit driving with a current MOT and up to date road tax
- Cars fitted with non-road legal slick tyres are not permitted
- No handheld cameras are allowed when driving
- All fixed cameras must be securely fitted. The marshals reserve the right to remove these on the day if they are not deemed to be safe
- Do NOT overfill petrol tanks
- The marshals reserve the right to refuse any car from being driven on the handling course or the drag strip – their decision is final

## DRAG STRIP

- Your mission is to accelerate from a standing start and cover the ¼ mile in the shortest possible time. A full performance print out after each run will show your reaction time, speed, and elapsed time as well as a host of incremental measurements
- You will need to show your driving licence at the sign-on office. Bring both parts in the case of photo card licences. Excuses such as it is with the DVLA/police will not be accepted. Photo copies will not be acceptable
- Your tyres must display a DOT mark and have road legal tread
- You MUST cover your arms and legs
- Seatbelts or harnesses must be worn at all times whilst driving
- You will need to keep your side windows wound up
- All drivers must wear a crash helmet – bring your own
